## AN ORDINANCE RENAMING CHICAGO STREET IN PORT AREA, MANILA TO ANTONIO C. DELGADO STREET.

WHEREAS, the late Ambassador to the Vatican, Antonio C. Delgado, built a business empire which for 45 years has been providing livelihood for thousands of Filipinos, particularly for the Manilenos;

WHEREAS, through the ambassador's vision and able stewardship, the Delgado Brothers, Incorporated (DELBROS, INC.), a family business, has grown to be a byword in the transportation industry in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, this success contributed immensely to the development and growth of our waterfront particularly at Port Area where most of his exploits can be witnessed and his influence most greatly felt;

WHEREAS, Ambassador Antonio C. Delgado is a man of unbounded greatness. who devoted his life in the pursuit of excellence, not only in business undertakings but also in socio, civic, religious and diplomatic endeavors here and abroad;

WHEREAS, the City of Manila has been the direct recipient of a lot of benefits from the ambassador's worthy endeavors: NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. Chicago Street in Port Area, Manila is hereby renamed to Antonio C. Delgado Street.

- SEC. 2. The City Engineer's Office shall immediately install the necessary street signs, indicating therein the former name of subject street, and other directional signs to effect the change in the name of the above street.
- SEC. 3. Copies of this Ordinance be furnished the Office of the President, the Representative of the 5th Legislative District of Manila, the Secretary General, House of Representatives, and the Philippine Postal Corporation.
- SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
