

ORDINANCE NO. 7947

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE GAT. ANDRES BONIFACIO MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER TONDO, IN THE 1ST DISTRICT OF MANILA, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR ITS ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared the policy of the City Government of Manila to provide and afford its residents especially the underprivileged, with sufficient hospitalization and medical services by establishing an adequately equipped and staffed public medical center for their medical needs.

SEC. 2. Pursuant to the above policy, there is hereby established in the First District of Manila a medical center to be known as the Gat. Andres Bonifacio Memorial Center Tondo, with the following objectives/functions:

1. Provide adequate medical and hospital services to the residents of the district and its environs, such as,

2. Provide laboratory, X-ray, Ultrasonography, Electrocardiogram (ECG), Computer Tomography (CT) Scan, Dialysis Machine, Respiratory Machine, Autoclave, Suction Apparatus and other ancillary services on a 24-hour basis;

3. Engage in policy formulation, decision-making, standard setting, research and development training, public information and education with regard to health matters;

4. Undertake extensive research for a more effective delivery of medical and allied services;

5. Provide a graduate program for medical trainees and undergraduate trainees (intern) for students from affiliated schools of nursing, medical technology, physical therapy, x-ray and;

6. Perform other related services.

SEC. 3. The Gat. Andres Bonifacio Memorial Medical Center Tondo shall establish close linkage with the Ospital ng Maynila, Ospital ng Sampaloc, Ospital ng Tondo and other City hospitals and health centers for technical collaboration, resource training, joint research work and other coordinated effort.

SEC. 4. The Gat. Andres Bonifacio Memorial Medical Center Tondo shall have an organizational structure and staffing, pattern as shown in Annex "A" hereof which is made an integral part of this Ordinance.

SEC. 5. The sum of TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THREE MILLION (P223,000,000.00) PESOS, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from any available funds of the City to be made available for the operation and maintenance of the Gat. Andres Bonifacio Memorial Medical Center Tondo for fiscal year 1998. The subsequent funding requirements of the medical center shall be incorporated in the annual budget of the City government.

SEC. 6. The regular medical and non-medical staff of the Gat. Andres Bonifacio Memorial Medical Center Tondo shall be appointed by the Mayor pursuant to existing Civil Service rules and regulations.


SEC. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




