ORDINANCE NO 7954

F ORDINANCE 7756, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE CONSTITUTING ONE (1) PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB) IN-EACH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF MANILA, PRESCRIBING. THE COMPOSITION AND TERM OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS NEEDED THEREFOR", AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 6 of Ordinance 7756 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Members of the PLEB, including those coming from the Sangguniang Panlungsod, shall receive honorarium in the amount as may be authorized in the annual appropriations ordinance: PROVIDED, That this provision shall likewise apply to previous members who have rendered actual services to the PLEB: PROVIDED FURTHER, That their honoraria shall be at the same rates prevailing at the time of their incumbency."

SEC. 2. Unless sooner adjusted, the Chairmen and Members of the PLER shall each receive monthly honorarium of P8,000.00 and P5,000.00, respectively.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
