

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE ONGPIN NORTH BRIDGE AS MANILA-BEIJING FRIENDSHIP BRIDGE AND THE ONGPIN SOUTH BRIDGE AS FILIPINO-CHINESE FRIENDSHIP BRIDGE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. The two (2) bridges located along Ongpin Street, Sta. Cruz, Manila, commonly referred to as Ongpin North Bridge is hereby named as *MANILA-BEIJING FRIENDSHIP BRIDGE* and the Ongpin South Bridge as *FILIPINO-CHINESE FRIENDSHIP BRIDGE*.

SEC. 2. The City Engineer is directed to implement the installation of the appropriate signages on the said bridges, as follows:

*Manila-Beijing Friendship Bridge*  
(Ongpin North Bridge)

*Filipino-Chinese Friendship Bridge*  
(Ongpin South Bridge)


SEC. 3. Copies of this Ordinance shall be furnished the Office of the President, the Representative of the Third District and the Philippine Postal Corporation.


SEC. 4. *Effectivity Clause.* -This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


