AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PHILHEALTH CAPITATION FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE OUTPATIENT CONSULTATION AND DIAGNOSTIC BENEFIT PACKAGE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) FOR QUALIFIED INDIGENT FAMILIES OF THE CITY OF MANILA UNDER THE INDIGENT SECTOR COMPONENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (NHIP).

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. *Title*. – This Ordinance shall be known as the "PhilHealth Capitation Fund Ordinance of the City of Manila".

- SEC. 2. *Fund Sourcing*. The PhilHealth Capitation Fund (PCF) shall come from the proceeds of the outpatient consultation and diagnostic benefit package to be provided by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) for qualified indigent families of City of Manila under the indigent sector component of the NHIP to enable them to have easy access to the medical and health services in all its accredited providers.
 - 2.1. The capitation amount shall be released on a quarterly basis by the Corporation under the following conditions:
 - 2.1.1. Initial release shall be subject to prior accreditation of the city-owned and managed Health Centers and the payment of the premium contribution by the City; and
 - 2.1.2. Succeeding release of quarterly capitation shall be subject to the submission of required monitoring/evaluation reports, research and program development as provided for under the Implementing Guidelines of the Outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic Package and prior payment of premiums in case of quarterly mode of remittance.
 - 2.2. The PhilHealth Corporation may withhold the release of the subsequent quarterly PCFs due to any of the following:
 - 2.2.1. Delay or non-payment of premium contribution;
 - 2.2.2. Violation of government accounting and auditing rules and regulations on the disbursement and liquidation of the PCFs; and
 - 2.2.3. Non-submission of the required reports under item 2.1.2 hereof.
 - SEC. 3. Utilization/Disposition. The use, management and disposition of the PhilHealth Capitation Fund shall be governed by the following rules:
 - 3.1. The disbursement and liquidation of the PCFs shall be in accordance with pertinent government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

 - 3.2. A separate book of accounts shall be maintained by the local government unit; and
 - 3.3. The capitation fund shall be used only for the specified purposes stipulated in the Outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic Package Guidelines.

SEC. 4. Effectivity Clause. - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
