ORDINANCE NO. 8264

**AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING BARANGAY 659-A, ZONE 71, DISTRICT V,
MANILA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session, assembled, *THAT*:

SECTION 1. Basis for the Authority to Abolish Local Government Units. -

Section 6, Chapter 2 of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states, that: "A local government unit may be created, divided, merged, abolished, or its boundaries substantially altered either by law enacted by Congress in the case of a province, city, municipality, or any other political subdivision, or by ordinance passed by the sangguniang panlalawigan or sangguniang panlungsod concerned in the case of a barangay located within its territorial jurisdiction, subject to such limitations and requirements prescribed in this code".

SEC. 2. Abolition of Local Government Unit. - Pursuant to Section 1, hereof, Barangay 659-A, Zone 71, District V, in the City of Manila, is hereby abolished: *PROVIDED*, That its territory, upon abolition, shall be incorporated to or merged with Barangay 659, Zone 71, District V, to comprise the following boundaries:

North - Riverside Drive
East - Ayala Boulevard
South - Taft Avenue
West - P. Burgos Street

SEC. 3. Selection and Transfer of Local Government Site, Offices and Facilities. - The governmental and corporate services of Barangay 659-A shall be delivered and performed by Barangay 659.


SEC. 4. Plebiscite Requirement. - In accordance with Section 10, Chapter 2 of R.A. 7160, the abolition and merger shall take effect after the approval by a majority of the votes cast in a plebiscite called for the purpose in the Barangay units concerned which shall be conducted by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) within one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of effectivity of this Ordinance, effecting such action.

SEC. 5. Separability Clause. - If, for any reason or reasons, any provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.




SEC. 6. Effectivity Clause. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
