ORDINANCE NO. 7689

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING A REVISED SCHEDULE OF RATE OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MANILA HEALTH DEPARTMENT RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSAL OF THE DEAD IN THE CITY OF MANILA; PROVIDING PENALTY THEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. The following revised schedule of rate of fees and charges for services rendered by the Manila Health Department relative to the disposal of the dead in the City of Manila is hereby prescribed:

SECTION 2. That the new rates imposed under this ordinance shall be posted conspicuously at the Offices of the North and South Cemeteries and in all funeral parlors in the City of Manila, and that copies thereof be furnished the universities and colleges offering medical and dental courses.

SECTION 3. All charges, fees and other impositions that shall be collected from this ordinance shall accrue to the general fund.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, resolutions, memoranda, rules and regulations, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
