

ORDINANCE NO. 1695

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, TRASH, RUBBISH AND REFUSE IN OPEN, UNCOVERED OR UNSEALED CONTAINER; PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1. Any and all person whether natural or juridical, in the City of Manila are hereby mandated to put their garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse in a closed or sealed trash bag, sack or similar container, the same to be closed and sealed for sanitary, orderly and proper disposition thereof.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person in the City of Manila to place outside of his residence or establishment his garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse in an open, uncovered or unsealed container.

SEC. 3. It shall be likewise unlawful for any person to open or destroy the aforesaid container for the purpose of scavenging and scattering the contents thereof in getting the said container.

SEC. 4. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable with an imprisonment of not more than ten (10) days or a fine of not more than Five Hundred (P500.00) Pesos, or both upon the discretion of the court.


SEC. 5. All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


