AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNER, PROPRIETORS, MANAGERS OR PERSON-IN-CHARGE · CF OPERATION OF ALL HOTELS, RESTAURANTS AND OTHER SIMILAR ESTAB-LISHEENTS TO STATE TAXES AND OTHER SERVICE CHARGES IF ANY ON THEIR MEHU OF FOOD, LIQUOR AND BEVERAGES; PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Owner, proprietors, managers or person-in-charge of operations of all hotels, restaurants and other similar establishments are hereby required to state mandatory taxes, service charges corkage and other miscellaneous charges that they impose on their menu of food, liquor and. beverages: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, Those establishments that do not imposed such service charges should indicate the same in their menu.

- SEC. 2. Motels, restaurants and other similar establishments offering food, liquor and beverages presently operating and doing business as such are hereby given a period of 60 days from the approval of this ordinance to comply with the provisions hereof.
- SEC. 3. Any person natural or juridical found guilty of violating this ordinance shall suffer a fine of P500.00. In case of juridical person, the President of Manager thereof shall be liable thereof.
- SEC. 4. Any establishment referred to above that violates this ordinance for the third time shall be a ground for the revocation of its license or permit to operate.
 - SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
