AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF THE MEDICO-LEGAL OFFICER OF THE CITY OF MANILA.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, that:

- SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known as the ordinance creating the Office of the Hedico-Legal Officer of the City of Manila as provided in REPUBLIC ACT NO. 409 otherwise known as the City Charter of the City of Manila.
- SEC. 2. The Office of the City Medico-Legal Officer of the City of Manila is hereby created, and shall be under the administrative & operational control and supervision of the Office of the Mayor and to serve public a nd private cases.
- SEC. 3. This Office as herein created in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be headed by the City Medico-Legal Officer and manned and composed of the following personnel staff:
 - 6 Medico-Legal Officers
 - 3 Medico-Legal Technologists
 - 4 Clerk/Typists
 - 3 Morgue Technicians
 - 6 Cadaver Removers
 - 3 Drivers
 - 2 Janitors
- SEC. 4. The above-mentioned personnel shall be hired/recruited pursuant to the standards/criteria set by existing Rules and Regulations and as prescribed by the City of Manila.
- of the above-mentioned personnel shall be compensated by the City of Manila out of the City funds, and in accordance with the corresponding rates prescribed by existing laws, rules and regulations and to be hereafter incorporated in the annual budget of the City.
- SEC. 6. The Office of the City Medico-Legal Officer, its personnel staff, facilities and operations thereof, shall be temporarily housed/stationed at the building presently being occupied by the office of the incumbent Medico-Legal Officer of the Western Police District at the Old Bilibid Prison Compound, Quezon Boulevard, Manila.

SEC. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
