ORDINANCE NO. 7722

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED THEOTO 3FET HILLION FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY—PESOS AND 59/100 (P827,568,250.59) AND FIFTY ONE MILLION (P51,000,000.00) PESOS AS TRANSFER TO INFRASTRUCTURE FUND OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY AND THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY NINE PESOS AND 41/100 (P123,571,749.41) OUT OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND AS THE 1990 EXECUTIVE BUDGET TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANILA TO BE TAKEN FROM THE ESTIMATED INCOME CERTIFIED AS REASONABLY COLLECTIBLE BY THE CITY TREASURER FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1990.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the funds of the City Treasury and from those estimated funds certified as reasonably collectible and which are not otherwise appropriated the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS and 59/100 (P827,568,250.59) and FIFTY ONE MILLION (P51,000,000.00) PESOS as transfer to Infrastructure Fund out of the General Fund to augment the SEVENTY TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY NINE PESOS and 41/100 (P72,571,749.41) Infrastructure Fund, thereby appropriating the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THREE NILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTYNINE PESOS and 41/100 (P123,571,749.41) or a total of NINE HUNDRED FIFTY ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND (P951,140,000.00) PESOS for both General and Infrastructure Fund, or so much thereof as may be necessary, as the 1990 Executive Budget and which budget documents marked as Annex "A" for Volume II and "B" for Volume I are made as integral part hereof, to be made available as appropriations of the City Government of Manila from January 1 to December 31, 1990.

The herein appropriation of funds represents authorized budgetary support of the following key programs necessary for the continued operation of the City Government of Manila for the ensuing Calendar Year.

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GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 2. CHANGES IN EXISTING ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE.

Unless otherwise authorized by law or ordinance, no changes in the existing organizational structure such as creation, consolidation, splitting, elevation, transfer and abolition of departments, offices and divisions including its functions shall be made and/or be funded from the appropriations provided under this ordinance. Organizational units created by administrative authorization shall be considered as Ad Hoc arrangements and shall be manned by contractual personnel, staff members on special or additional assignment or by temporary or casual personnel.

SEC. 3. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PERMANENT POSITION

Except as otherwise provided by law, the maximum number of permanent positions included in the approved itemization of personnel schedule and the amount of salaries chargeable against the appropriation under this ordinance for personal services shall not exceed the rates as approved under existing laws as adjusted by NCC No. 51 and 52. Changes in designation, itle or nomenclature of existing positions that will result in a promotion or demotion in rank and/or increase or decrease in compensation shall not be authorized except when the position is actually vacant.

SEC. 4. ITEMIZATION OF PERSONAL SERVÍCES

The Itemization of Personal Services in support of the priation herein authorized for personal services together the approved implementing rules and regulations shall orm part of this ordinance and shall be governed by its rovisions.

SEC. 5. DISCRETIONARY FUND OF CITY MAYOR

Appropriation for discretionary fund of the City Mayor hall not exceed one percent (1%) of the total real property ax collections actually realized during the next preceeding alendar year or P100,000.00, whichever is lower.

SEC. 6. INTELLIGENCE FUND

Intelligence Funds provided for under this ordinance hall be used solely for security and intelligence activities nd disbursement thereof shall be subject to pertinent counting and auditing rules and regulations.

SEC. 7. TWO PERCENT CALAMITY FUND

Appropriations for the 2% Calamity Fund shall be isbursed solely for emergency expenditures for relief, repair and rehabilitation in terms of natural calamities, "force ajeure" or other unforseen events.

SEC. 9. POWER OF THE CITY MAYOR TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS.

Upon request of the head of department or office concerned and upon favorable recommendation by the Budget Officer, the City Mayor may transfer, without need of a supplemental budget, funds appropriated for a particular item or items under a Project to another Project of the same Program for "Current Operating Expenditures" of the Office/Department except appropriations for "Personal Services", "Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses" corresponding to insurance, rentals, water and illumination/power, and "Capital Outlays" or for settlement of "Statutory and Contractual Obligat ons."

SEC. 10. TWENTY PERCENT CONTINGENCY FESERVE.

The mandatory reserve of 20% on the author zed 1990 appropriation for Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses shall be rovided. For the purpose, all department/office heads are enjoined to prepar a Work and Financial Plan and Request for Allotment indicating therein the 20% contingency reserve except mandatory accounts and those amount fixed by contract.

SEC. 11. ALLOTMENT OF APPROPRIATIONS.

For effective budgetary control, authorized appropriations shall be alloted in accordance with Local Budget Circular No. 16 as outlyined hereunder:

- a) No appropriation authorized for any department or office of the City of Manila shall be available for expenditure until the head of each department or office shall have submitted to the City Budget Officer a Work and Financial Plan and Request for Allotment of funds showing the estimated amounts needed for each function, activity or purpose for which the funds are to be expended during the applicable allotment period until an Advice of Allotment for said request shall have been approved by the City Mayor as hereinafter provided. The forms of the Work and Financial Plan and Request for Allotment shall be Local Budget Executive Form No. 162 and 162-A and shall be submitted to the City Budget Officer not less than twenty-five (25) days prior to the beginning of the PROVIDED, THAT, in case the annual ensuing calendar year; budget is approved after December 6 of each calendar year, the Work and Financial Plan and Request fer Allotment shall be submitted based on appropriations author zed in the budget ordinance of the immediately preceeding calendar year as amended by supplemental budget ordinance taking into consideration the provisions of Section 26 of PD 477'. A revised Work and Financial Plan and Request for Allotment shall be submitted upon approval of the annual executive budget referred to herein, showing quarterly allotments of the whole authorized appropriations for the department or office.
- b) For the purpose of the allotment system here in provided, each calendar year shall be divided into four (4) quarterly allotment periods, beginning respectively on the first day of January, April, July and October.
- c) The City Mayor may require heads of department/offices to revise their Work and Financial Plan and Request for Allotment upon the Local Treasurer's

notification and certification that the realized income is less than what is estimated in the annual/
supplemental budget or that additional income is
realized.

d). An Advice of Allotment shall be prepared by the City Budget Offices utilizing Local Budget Executive Form No. 163 based on recommendations made in the Work and Financial Plan and Request for Allotment and upon the recommendation of said officia the City Mayor shall approve the Work and innancial Plan and Request for Allotment and the Advice of Allotment at least live (5) days before the start of each quarter.

SEC. 12. DATE OF EFFECTIVITY.

This ordinance shall take effect on January, one nineteen hundred and ninety.
