

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RE-NUMBERING AND RE-MEASURING OF MARKET STALLS IN THE PUBLIC MARKETS OF THE CITY OF MANILA AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. Each stall, stand or allotted space for the use of vendors in the various public markets of the City of Manila shall be re-measured and allocated a new number with the name and picture of the awardee conspicuously displayed to determine compliance with existing provisions of ordinances.

SEC. 2. The Market Committee is hereby directed to formulate rules and regulations to carry out the provision of Section 1 hereof subject to the approval of the City Council and the City Mayor.

SEC. 3. The approved rules and regulations shall be effective 30 days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the City and posting thereof in conspicuous places within the premises of the public markets.

SEC. 4. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to deprive any legitimate stallholder of his rights thereto.

SEC. 5. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of P1,000.00 or imprisonment of 30 days or both at the discretion of the court.

In case of public officers, forfeiture of benefits shall be imposed, in addition thereto.

SEC. 6. All provisions of ordinances, rules and regulations not inconsistent herewith shall continue to remain in force.

SEC. 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
