

ORDINANCE NO. 7751

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE 31ST OF JULY AS THE FOUNDING DATE OF THE MANILA CITY COUNCIL FORMERLY KNOWN AND CALLED AS THE MUNICIPAL BOARD OF MANILA.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Every 31st day of July of the year is hereby declared as the "MANILA CITY COUNCIL DAY" in commemoration of the date when the law creating the local legislative body, then known as the Municipal Board of Manila, was enacted by the Philippine Commission on July 31, 1901.

SEC. 2. Appropriate activities commemorating the founding date of the Manila City Council are authorized to be held.

SEC. 3. All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations that are not in conformity or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
