

ORDINANCE NO. 1777

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY FORM OF RECLAMATION ALONG MANILA BAY, FROM THE U.S. EMBASSY TO THE CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. Any form of reclamation along Manila Bay, from the U.S. Embassy to the Cultural Center of the Philippines, in the City of Manila, is hereby prohibited.

SEC. 2. The violation of this ordinance shall be punished with a fine of ₱5,000.00 or imprisonment for a period of one (1) year or both upon the discretion of the Court. In case of juridical person, the penalty shall be imposed on the President or General Manager of the said establishment.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon its publication in two newspapers of general circulation in the City.

Enacted by the City Council of Manila at its regular session today, December 15, 1992.




