

ORDINANCE NO. 7789

AN ORDINANCE NAMING AND IDENTIFYING CERTAIN STREETS IN BARANGAY 738, ZONE 80, SAN ANDRES, MALATE, 5th DISTRICT OF MANILA FOR PURPOSES OF LOCATION AND IDENTIFICATION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. The street from North to South near the Estero Tripa de Gallina be named **NAGKAISA STREET**; the street from North to South before Muñoz Street from the East is named **NAGKAISA STREET**; the first street from North of San Andres Street, from East to West be named **MASAYA STREET**; the second street North of San Andres Street, from East to West up to Muñoz Street be named **MATIWASAY STREET**; the third street North of San Andres Street, from East to West be named **MALAYAPA STREET**; all situated in Barangay 738, Zone 80, San Andres, Malate, 5th District of Manila.

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted by the City Council of Manila at its regular session today, March 11, 1993.


