

ORDINANCE NO. 7865

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE DISPLAY OF THE PHILIPPINE FLAG IN FRONT OF RESIDENTIAL HOUSES, COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, OFFICE AND INSTITUTIONAL BUILDINGS AND OTHER STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF MANILA FROM MAY 28 TO JUNE 12 EVERY YEAR.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared a policy of the City government of Manila to foster and develop nationalism or love of country in each and every resident of the City, as a way of contributing to national solidarity.

SEC. 2. Pursuant to the above policy, every owner, administrator, or occupant-tenant of any residential house, commercial, industrial, office and institutional building and other structures in the City of Manila is hereby required to display the Philippine flag conspicuously in front of their houses or establishments, from May 28 to June 12, every year.

SEC. 3. The minimum size and manner of displaying the Philippine Flag shall be as follows:

<u>Type of Structures</u>	<u>Size of Flag Minimum Size</u>	<u>Manner of Display</u>
1. Residential houses	1 ft x 2 ft	to be posted with the blue part of flag placed on the right side
2. Commercial, industrial and business office buildings		
a. per unit/store	2 ft x 4 ft	-do-
b. building	3 ft x 6 ft	hoisted/attached to pole, either standing on the ground or leaning from the wall
3. Institutional buildings like school, hospital, government office, etc.	3 ft x 6 ft	hoisted/attached to pole standing on the ground

SEC. 4. Any person, natural or juridical, found violating this Ordinance shall be meted a penalty of a fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) or imprisonment for two months, or both, upon the discretion of the court; PROVIDED: That, in the case of a juridical person, the President, General Manager or person-in-charge of operations shall be held liable.

SEC. 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All existing Ordinances and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

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SEC. 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for some reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts not affected shall remain effective and in force.


SEC. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following its publication.


