

ORDINANCE NO. 7871

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A ROUTE-MEASURE CAPACITY (R.M.C.) FRANCHISE ISSUANCE SYSTEM FOR THE OPERATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY TRICYCLES IN THE CITY OF MANILA, PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREFOR AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, **THAT:**

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known as the Manila Tricycle Franchising System.

SEC. 2. The issuance of tricycle franchise shall be determined by association and routes quota, as specified hereunder:

SEC. 3. The imposition of fees and charges shall be governed by, and in consonance with, Section 6 of City Ordinance No. 7790.

SEC. 4. The Transport Regulatory Unit under the Bureau of Permits is hereby granted the authority to promulgate rules and guidelines for the smooth operation of tricycles, subject to the approval of the City Council.

SEC. 4a. The said Unit shall likewise submit to the City Council a quarterly report on franchises granted.

SEC. 5. Any franchise issued under and by virtue of this Ordinance shall be valid for a maximum of three (3) years from date of issuance thereof.




SEC. 6. Any official or employee found violating this Ordinance shall be held liable administratively.




