ORDINANCE NO. 7887

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING FROM PUBLIC USE PORTIONS OF COMMERCIO AND MUELLE DE BINONDO STREETS IN THE DIVISORIA MARKET AREA, SAN NICOLAS, MANILA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVERTING THE SAME AS VENDING AREAS OF FISH CONSIGNEES (CONSIGNATORES) UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from public use of portions of Commercio and Muelle de Binondo Streets in the Divisoria Market area, San Nicolas, Manila, for the purpose of converting the same as vending areas of fish consignees (consignatores) is hereby authorized, subject to the following conditions:

- The fish stalls to be constructed shall measure 1.20 x 4.00 meters:
- 2. The fish stalls shall be temporary in nature and shall be removed at the expense of the consignees in the event that the City will implement its urban renewal/improvement of the area:
- 3. The building and ancillary permits for the stalls shall be first secured from the Office of the City Building Official;
- 4. Other permits, licenses and fees mandated by laws and ordinances shall be paid; and
- 5. Sanitation within the premises shall be properly maintained, including proper collection and disposal of garbage.
- SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
