ORDINANCE NO. 8497

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MANILA DEPARTMENT OF ARCHITECTURE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, DEFINING ITS COMPOSITION, OBJECTIVES AND FUNCTIONS, AND OTHER RELATED PURPOSES

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, THAT:

SECTION 1. Creation of the Manila Department of Architecture. — It is hereby created the Manila Department of Architecture (hereinafter the "Department"), the composition and functions of which are hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. Composition. – The following positions, with the corresponding qualifications and salary grades indicated, are hereby created to compose the Department, subject to existing civil service laws, rules and regulations:

- SEC. 3. Organization. Subject to existing civil service laws, rules and regulations, the Department shall have such divisions and organizational structure as illustrated in the organizational chart attached as Annex A hereof.
- SEC. 4. Rank and Privileges of the City Architect. The City Architect shall have the rank and enjoy the privileges of a department head in the City Government.
- SEC. 5. Appointment. Subject to existing civil service laws, rules and regulations, the City Architect shall be appointed by the City Mayor, under whose control and supervision the former shall serve.
- SEC. 6. Powers and Functions. The Department shall take charge of the city's overall architectural planning and design and shall:
 - a) Formulate measures for the consideration of the City Council and provide technical assistance and support to the City Mayor in carrying out measures to ensure the delivery of basic services and provision of adequate facilities relative to architectural planning and design as provided for under Section 17 of the Local Government Code and Rule V of the Implementing Rules and Regulations thereof;
 - Develop plans and strategies on architectural planning and design programs and projects and implement them upon approval thereof by the City Mayor;
 - c) Prepare and recommend for consideration of the City Council the architectural plan and design for the city or a part thereof, including the renewal of slums and blighted areas, land reclamation activities, the greening of land, and appropriate planning of marine and foreshore areas;
 - d) Review and recommend for appropriate action of the City Council or City Mayor the architectural plans and design submitted by governmental and non- governmental entities or individuals, particularly those for undeveloped, underdeveloped, and poorly- designed areas;
 - e) Coordinate with government and non- government entities and individuals involved in the aesthetics and the maximum utilization of the land and water within the jurisdiction of the city, compatible with environmental integrity and ecological balance;
 - f) Be in the frontline of the delivery of services involving architectural planning and design, particularly those related to the redesigning of spatial distribution of basic facilities and physical structures during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural calamities and disasters;
 - g) Recommend to the City Council and advise the City Mayor on all other matters relative to the architectural planning and design as it relates to the total socio-economic development of the local government unit; and
 - h) Exercise such other powers and perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned by the City Mayor in accordance with law and this Ordinance.

- SEC. 7. Functional Realignment. The functions of the Urban Planning and Development Division and of the Architectural Section of the Designing Division of the Manila Department of Engineering and Public Works shall be transferred to and absorbed by the Manila Department of Architecture. Subject to existing civil service laws, rules and regulations, the occupants of the positions affected, by this reorganization may either be absorbed in the Department or retained in the Manila Department of Engineering and Public Works.
 - SEC. 8. Budgetary Appropriation. To carry out the objectives of this Ordinance, the initial amount of Thirty Million Pesos (PhP. 30,000,000.00), is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated.

For each succeeding fiscal year, a budgetary appropriation for the salaries of personnel and the operations of the Department, in an amount to be approved by the City Council, shall automatically be included in the annual budget of the city.

- SEC. 9. Separability Clause. If any provision or part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by competent authority, the remainder or provisions not otherwise affected and dependent thereon shall remain valid and subsisting.
- SEC. 10. Repealing Clause. Existing ordinances, orders or administrative regulations that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, if any, are hereby amended, modified, superseded or repealed accordingly.
- SEC. 11. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or a newspaper of general circulation.

This Ordinance was finally enacted by the City Council of Manila on June 28, 2016.

Please be informed that His Honor, Mayor Joseph Ejercito Estrada, has vetoed Ordinance No. 8497 pursuant to Section 54 of Republic Act 7610 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991. The veto is premised on the following grounds:

- 1. The passage of Ordinance No, 8479 will violate the limitations on personnel services under Section \$25 of the Local Government Code; and
- 2. The creation of Manila Department of Architecture is redundant considering the similar functions and services being performed by the City Planning and Development Office.


