**ORDINANCE NO. 8742**

**AN ORDINANCE** AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 05, SERIES OF 2021 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE MANILA COVID-19 FIELD HOSPITAL, THE INTENSIVE CARE UNITS OF HOSPITALS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF MANILA

## PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act. No. 11469 provides that "Presidential Proclamation No. 922, s. 2020, was issued declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and the Code Alert System for COVID-19 was raised to Code Red Sublevel Two (2) in accordance with the recommendation of the Department of Health (DOH) and the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases. Further, Presidential Proclamation No. 929, s. 2020, was issued declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines and imposed an Enhanced Community Quarantine throughout Luzon. Proclamation No. 1021 then extended the period of the State of Calamity throughout the Philippines until September 12, 2021;

WHEREAS, both Proclamations enjoined all government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs) to render full assistance to and cooperation with each other and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate disaster response aid and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, in the same law, the President is empowered to "ensure that all Local Government Units (LGUs) are acting within the letter and spirit of all the rules, regulations and directives issued by the National Government pursuant to the said law, and are implementing standards of Community Quarantine consistent with what the National Government has laid down for the subject area, while allowing the LGUs to continue exercising their autonomy in matters undefined by the National Government or are within the parameters it has set; and are fully cooperating towards a unified, cohesive and orderly implementation of the national policy to address COVID-19." (**Section 4 (g) of RA No. 11469**);

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise its powers for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, promote health and safety, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants. [(**Section 16 of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 7160 or the Local Government Code**);

WHEREAS, the local government units are authorized to enact a supplemental budget when supported by funds actually available as certified by the local treasurer or by new revenue sources (**Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160**);

WHEREAS, the local legislative body approved Resolution No. 05, Series of 2021, adopted by the Executive Committee of the City Development Council on April 19, 2021, entitled: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM AND THE ISSUANCE OF A SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR FY 2021 FOR THE MANILA COVID-19 FIELD HOSPITAL, THE INTENSIVE CARE UNITS OF HOSPITALS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF MANILA": NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, *THAT*:

**SECTION 1. Appropriations.** – The amount of Nine Hundred Thirty Million Pesos (PhP. 930,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated for the Manila COVID-19 Field Hospital, the Intensive Care Units of Hospitals and Other Requirements of the City of Manila, as follows:




