

ORDINANCE No 2926

AN ORDINANCE PENALIZING ANY RETAILER ON ARTICLES OF PRIME NECESSITY OR FOODSTUFFS, OWNER OR MANAGER OF RETAIL STORES, RESTAURANTS AND CAFETERIAS, WHO REFUSES TO MAKE SMALL CHANGE TO THE EXTENT OF ONE PESO TO ANY PERSON WHO BUYS ANY COMMODITY, GOODS, FOOD OR DRINK FROM HIS STORE OR PLACE OF BUSINESS; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any retailer dealing on articles of prime necessity or foodstuffs, owner or manager of retail stores, restaurants and cafeterias to refuse to make small change to the extent of one peso (P1.00) to any person who buys any commodity, goods, food or drink from his store or place of business.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not more than one month, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on September 15, 1945.
