

ORDINANCE No. *2934*
2934

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF P50,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THREE-MONTHS' PAY TO OFFICIALS, EMPLOYERS AND LABORERS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF MANILA, WHO HAVE NOT RECEIVED SAME IN 1941 PRIOR TO THE JAPANESE OCCUPATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF COMMONWEALTH ACT NO. 676.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. All officials, employees and laborers in the employ of the Government of the City of Manila, prior to December 31, 1941, who were not able to collect the three-months' pay, as authorized by Commonwealth Act No. 676, shall be paid by the City Treasurer upon presentation of document duly signed by his immediate chief or department head.

SEC. 2. Persons who have already received their three-months' salary, and because for lack of records, have been able to collect again a similar amount by virtue of this ordinance shall be made to reimburse the same amount and shall also be criminally prosecuted therefor.

SEC. 3. The sum of P50,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available for the payment of the three-months' pay to officials, employees and laborers of the Government of the City of Manila, in accordance with Section one hereof.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
