

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION SIX HUNDRED FIFTY OF ORDINANCE NUMBERED ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED, KNOWN AS "THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA", BY INCREASING THE FEES FOR THE STORAGE OF ANY EXPLOSIVE OR COMBUSTIBLE SUBSTANCES PROVIDED FOR THEREIN.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 650 of Ordinance No. 1600, known as the Revised Ordinances of the City of Manila, as amended by Ordinance No. 2511, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 650. Fees.- There shall be paid for each license granted for storage of any explosive or combustible substances as herein provided, an annual fee as follows:

Calcium carbide over 2 cases of 240 pounds each, but not more than 100 cases -----	P100.00
Calcium carbide over 100 cases of 240 pounds each, but not more than 150 cases --	200.00
Calcium carbide over 150 cases of 240 pounds each, but not more than 200 cases --	300.00
Calcium carbide over 200 cases of 240 pounds each, but not more than 250 cases --	350.00
Calcium carbide over 250 cases of 240 pounds each, but not more than 350 cases --	450.00
Gasoline over than 10 gallons, but not more than 500 gallons -----	100.00
Gasoline over 500 gallons, but not more than 1,000 gallons -----	175.00
Gasoline over 1,000 gallons, but not more than 1,500 gallons -----	225.00
Gasoline over 1,500 gallons, but not more than 2,000 gallons -----	300.00
Gasoline over 2,000 gallons, but not more than 5,000 gallons -----	1,000.00
Gasoline over 5,000 gallons, but not more than 50,000 gallons -----	1,600.00
Gasoline over 50,000 gallons, but not more than 200,000 gallons -----	2,500.00
Gasoline over 200,000 gallons, but not more than 500,000 gallons -----	3,000.00
Gasoline over than 500,000 gallons, but not more than 1,500,000 gallons -----	4,500.00
Gasoline over than 1,500,000 gallons -----	6,000.00

PROVIDED, That when any gasoline storage is operated in connection with a motor vehicle service, the license fee for such storage shall be increased by an amount equivalent to thirty per centum of the license fee provided therefor herein above.

Petroleum or kerosene over 25 gallons, but not more than 500 gallons -----	100.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 500 gallons but not more than 3,000 gallons -----	200.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 3,000 gallons but not more than 10,000 gallons -----	350.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 10,000 gallons, but not more than 30,000 gallons -----	450.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 30,000 gallons, but not more than 100,000 gallons -----	650.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 100,000 gallons, but not more than 200,000 gallons -----	800.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 200,000 gallons, but not more than 300,000 gallons -----	1,000.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 300,000 gallons, but not more than 400,000 gallons -----	1,500.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 400,000 gallons, but not more than 500,000 gallons -----	1,700.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 500,000 gallons, but not more than 600,000 gallons -----	2,000.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 600,000 gallons, but not more than 700,000 gallons -----	2,400.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 700,000 gallons, but not more than 900,000 gallons -----	2,900.00
Petroleum or kerosene over 900,000 gallons, but not more than 1,000,000 gallons -----	3,200.00
Crude petroleum over 20 gallons, but less than 500 gallons -----	20.00
Crude petroleum over 500 gallons, but less than 2,000 gallons -----	30.00
Crude petroleum over 2,000 gallons, but less than 50,000 gallons -----	40.00
Crude petroleum over 50,000 gallons, but less than 100,000 gallons -----	100.00
Crude petroleum over 100,000 gallons, but less than 200,000 gallons -----	170.00
Crude petroleum over 200,000 gallons, but less than 400,000 gallons -----	350.00
Crude petroleum over 400,000 gallons, but less than 600,000 gallons -----	500.00
Crude petroleum over 600,000 gallons, but less than 800,000 gallons -----	800.00
Crude petroleum 800,000 gallons or over -----	1,000.00
Gastarls over 10 gallons, but not more than 1,000 gallons -----	100.00
Gastarls over 1,000 gallons -----	250.00
Gasanol over 10 gallons, but not more than 1,000 gallons -----	100.00
Gasanol over 1,000 gallons -----	250.00

OTHER SUBSTANCES FOR FUEL OF MOTORS OVER TEN  
GALLONS BUT NOT EXCEEDING

1,000 gallons -----	100.00
Over 1,000 gallons -----	200.00
Cinematograph films with total aggregate weight of not more than 500 kilos -----	75.00
Cinematograph films with a total aggregate weight of more than 500 kilos but not more than 2,000 kilos -----	200.00
Cinematograph films with a total aggregate weight of more than 2,000 kilos -----	400.00

Tar over 100 kilos but not more than 5,000 kilos -----	100.00
Tar over 5,000 kilos -----	200.00
Resin over 100 kilos but not more than 5,000 kilos -----	100.00
Resin over 5,000 kilos -----	200.00
Other combustible materials -----	100.00

PROVIDED, That combustible materials enumerated below, not exceeding the following quantities, are hereby exempted from the payment of license fee of P100.00 above mentioned:

1. Benzine ----- 10 gallons
2. Alcohol ----- 10 gallons
3. Naptha ----- 10 gallons
4. Turpentine ----- 10 gallons
5. Pitch ----- 50 kilos
6. Matches ----- 100 kilos
7. Celluloid ----- 10 kilos
8. Kapok or cotton ----- 10 kilos
9. Straw ----- 50 kilos
10. Excelsior ----- 50 kilos
11. Any other combustible materials not specified above - 50 kilos

PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the Chief of the Fire Department shall have supervision of the location and manner of storing the aforementioned quantities of combustible materials which are herein exempted from the payment of the license fee, and if in his judgement the location and manner of storing any of such combustible materials is dangerous he shall issue an order to the possessor, directing that the same be stored properly or removed within twenty four hours: AND PROVIDED, FINALLY, That all gasoline deposits and all storage of explosive or combustible substances of any kind whatsoever belonging to the UNITED STATES ARMY FORCES, PACIFIC, or any branch, depot or subdivision thereof, or to any office or agency of the COMMONWEALTH GOVERNMENT, shall be exempted from the requirements of this section, both as to the securing of permit and the payment of fees herein provided."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
