WAR VICTIMS FROM THE PAYMENT OF THE
BUILDING PERMIT FEES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
HOUSES OR BUILDINGS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

AND WHEREAS, many bona fide residents of the City, whose houses
were destroyed during the war operation, have not yet constructed
their buildings because their lands, upon liberation of Manila,
have been occupied by the United States Army;

WHEREAS, many of those properties have been released by the
United States Army, so that the owners thereof can now proceed
to erect their dwellings thereon; Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila,
that:


SECTION 1. War victims are hereby exempted from the pay-
ment of the necessary building permit fees for the construction
of their houses or buildings in any place within the limits of
the City of Manila, the cost of which shall not exceed P2000.00;
PROVIDED, that they can show proof to the satisfaction of the
City Engineer that their houses or buildings were destroyed or
burned during the last war operation in Manila; AND PROVIDED
FURTHER, That, before erecting such house or building, they
should obtain a permit from the Office of the City Engineer in
accordance with the provisions of the City Ordinances.


SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall be enforced for a period of
six months after its approval.


