

ORDINANCE NO. 2991

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY OWNER, MANAGER OR OPERATOR OF ANY PUBLIC EATING PUBLIC PLACE OR ESTABLISHMENT TO OFFER FOR SALE OR SERVE ANY MEAT TO THE PUBLIC OTHER THAN THAT OF ANIMALS OR FOWLS SLAUGHTERED AND EXAMINED IN THE CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE; IMPOSING EXAMINATION FEE ON MEAT COMING FROM THE PROVINCES AND FOREIGN COUNTRIES; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that

SECTION 1. No owner, manager or operator of any public eating place or establishment shall offer for sale or serve meat or fowls meat other than that of animals and fowls slaughtered and examined in the city slaughterhouse; PROVIDED, That meat or fowl meat already dressed (in frozen form or otherwise) coming from territories outside the limits of the City of Manila may be allowed to be offered for sale or sold if the same is accompanied by a certificate of a government veterinarian stating that the slaughtered animal has passed the ante-mortem and post-mortem examinations and duly found to be fit for human consumption. PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the said meat shall first pass through the city slaughterhouse or any other station or place designated by the City Health Officer for the purpose of subjecting the same to another examination by a city Veterinarian before it is offered for sale or sold or stored in any cold storage AND PROVIDED, FINALLY, That of meat coming from the Southern Islands an inspection fee of ten centavos (P0.10) per kilo of meat and five centavos (P0.05) per kilo of fowls meat, or fraction thereof, and of that coming from the provinces of Luzon and from foreign countries a fee of fifteen centavos (P0.15) per kilo of meat and five centavos (P0.05) per kilo of fowl meat, or fraction thereof, shall be collected.

SEC. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than fifty pesos nor more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 3. All ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
