

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING AND FIXING NEW RATES OF LICENSE FEES ON BARBER SHOPS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Permit, license.- No person shall conduct or engage in the business, trade or calling of barbering without first having obtained a permit from the Mayor and a license from the City Treasurer which shall be issued upon presentation of such permit.

SEC. 2. Fees.- For every license granted under the provisions of this ordinance, there shall be paid an annual license fee as herein provided, payable quarterly, semestraly, or annually, at the option of the payer.

BARBER SHOPS:

Class A - Those located at the following plazas, streets or public places: Plaza Santa Cruz; Plaza Goiti; Plaza Moraga; Plaza Miranda, Escolta; Nueva; Dasmariñas; Candara; T. Pinpin; Ongpin; Teodora Alonso; Real; San Luis; Rizal Ave. from Echague to Azcarraga; Bustos from Plaza Sta. Cruz to Rizal Avenue; Ronquillo from Plaza Sta. Cruz to Rizal Ave.; Echague from Plaza Goiti to the approach of the Echague Bridge; Carriedo from Plaza Goiti to Plaza Miranda; Azcarraga from Rizal Ave. to Aguilar; Quezon Boulevard from the east side of the Pasig River to Azcarraga; Estero Cegado from Echague to Carriedo; P. Gomez from Echague to Carriedo; M. N. del Pilar from San Luis to Herran.

- (1) For each barber shop with one mechanical chair and for location only P 10.00
- (2) For each additional mechanical chair 5.00
- (3) For each barber shop with one ordinary chair and for location only 5.00
- (4) For each additional ordinary chair 2.00

Class B - Those located at places not enumerated in Class A:

- (1) For each barber shop with one mechanical chair and for location only 6.00
- (2) For each additional mechanical chair 3.00
- (3) For each barber shop with one ordinary chair and for location only 3.00
- (4) For each additional ordinary chair 1.00

Class C - Itinerant barbers without fixed place of business 2.00

SEC. 3. Penalty.- Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.


SEC. 4. Repealing clause.- The provisions of Secs. 610, 611, and 612 of Ordinance No. 1600, of the City of Manila and of other ordinances, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.


SEC. 5. Effectivity.- This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
