

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CALTEX (PHILIPPINES) INC. TO INSTALL TWO GASOLINE PUMPS AND 1000-GALLON CAPACITY UNDERGROUND TANK ON THE SITE LOCATED ON THE EAST OF TAFT AVENUE BETWEEN PADRE FAURA AND OREGON STREETS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE ZONIFICATION ORDINANCE AND ORDINANCE NO. 2809 REGARDING INSTALLATION OF GASOLINE PUMP STATIONS, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The Caltex (Philippines) Inc., is hereby exempted from the provisions of the Zonification Ordinance and Ordinance No. 2809 regarding the installation of gasoline pump stations, in connection with its application for the installation of two gasoline pumps and 1000-gallon capacity underground tank on the site located on the east of Taft Avenue between Padre Faura and Oregon Streets: PROVIDED, That the permit to install this gasoline station shall only be for one year from the date of construction and extendible from year to year not exceeding five (5) years and that the gasoline station shall be constructed as economically and simply as possible.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
