

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, AND 4, OF ORDINANCE NUMBERED TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE PRESCRIBING FINES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE CONVEYANCE OR TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVES, INFLAMMABLE LIQUIDS OR COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS OVER THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF MANILA, AS WELL AS FOR THE LOADING OR UNLOADING OF SUCH EXPLOSIVES, INFLAMMABLE LIQUIDS OR COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS IN OR FROM ANY RAILWAY CONVEYANCE, VESSEL, BOAT OR CRAFT.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, of Ordinance No. 2971 are

hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Permits.- It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to convey or transport any explosives, inflammable liquid or combustible material over the streets of the City of Manila or to load or unload such explosive, inflammable liquid or combustible material in or from any vessel, boat or craft, or railway conveyance without first having obtained a permit therefor from the Chief of the Fire Department.

SEC. 2. Fees.- For every permit granted under the provisions of this Ordinance, the following fees shall be paid:

| (1) a. <u>Cargo trucks</u> carrying a load not exceeding 500 gallons of inflammable liquids with a flash point of 200°F or below (closed cup tester), for each permit which shall be good for a period of thirty (30) days only | P 5.00 |
| For every additional 100 gallons or fraction thereof | .20 |
| b. For loading other inflammable liquids with a flash point over 200°F but not more than 500°F (closed cup tester), for each permit which shall be good for a period of thirty (30) days only | 3.00 |
| For every additional 100 gallons or fraction thereof | .10 |
| (2) For <u>cargo trucks</u> carrying a load not exceeding 500 kilos of explosives and/or combustible materials, including hazardous chemicals and gases, for a period of thirty (30) days | 3.00 |
| For every additional 100 kilos or fraction thereof | .10 |
| (3) Tank trucks, tank trailers, and tank semi-trailers carrying inflammable liquids described in sub-paragraph 1 hereof, for each permit which shall be good for a period of thirty (30) days only: | |
| For 500-gallon capacity tanks | 5.00 |
| For every additional 100 gallon capacity or fraction thereof | .50 |

- (4) For each transfer of inflammable liquids described in sub-paragraph hereof, to shore tanks at Pandacan Terminal, to include discharge of inflammable cargo from tankers to bulk lighters undertaken at Manila Bay and its subsequent transportation by water to petroleum wharves, the permit to be issued shall be deemed to cover the whole operation as follows:

For the first 500 gallons	P 2.00
For every additional 100 gallons or fraction thereof not exceeding 100,000 gallons50
For every additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof in excess of 100,000 gallons10

- (5) For each transfer of packages or containers of explosives, inflammable liquids, or other combustible materials, including hazardous chemicals and gases at the Manila Port Terminal or Manila North Harbor piers, to vessel, boat or craft, or vice versa, and for loading and unloading railway tank cars thereof, for each permit which shall cover the whole operation of loading or unloading to or from boat, vessel, craft, or railway tank car:

For the first 500 gallons or kilos	1.00
For every additional 100 gallons or 100 kilos or fraction thereof not exceeding 10,000 gallons or 10,000 kilos10
For every additional 1,000 gallons or 1,000 kilos or fraction thereof in excess of 10,000 gallons or 10,000 kilos05

PROVIDED, That the Government of the Republic of the Philippines or any of its political subdivisions, the United States Army and Navy, United States Embassy and Members of its staff, diplomatic and consular representatives and officers of foreign powers, are hereby exempted from the imposition of the fees mentioned herein.

SEC. 3. Manner of transportation, etc.- The Chief of Fire Department shall determine the classification of the inflammable liquids subject of the payment of fees herein and the manner in which the inflammable liquids, explosives or combustible materials shall be transported, if by vehicle, or transferred, if in a railway car, vessel, boat or craft.

SEC. 4. Penalty.- Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding two hundred pesos or by imprisonment of not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court."

SEC. 2. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


