

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE TO THE BRITISH LEGATION THAT PORTION OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTY AT THE SOUTH CEMETERY KNOWN AS BLOCK NO. 13 (SPECIAL SECTION) 16 LOTS IN ALL, FOR THE PERMANENT BURIAL GROUND OF THE REMAINS OF THE BRITISH ARMED FORCES WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN THE PHILIPPINES DURING THE LAST WAR, FOR A NOMINAL PRICE OF ONE PESO.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The sale of that portion of the City-owned property at the South Cemetery known as Block No. 13 (Special Section) Lots Nos. 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76 and 77 with an aggregate area of 420 square meters to the British Legation for the permanent burial ground of the remains of the British Armed Forces who lost their lives in the Philippines during the last war, for a nominal price of one peso (P1.00), is hereby authorized, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 12 of the Internal Regulations for the Cementerio del Sur.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
