

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION SEVEN HUNDRED AND TWO OF ORDINANCE NUMBERED SIXTEEN HUNDRED, KNOWN AS THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA, REQUIRING ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS TO MAKE DEPOSITS AS GUARANTY FOR THE PAYMENT OF ELECTRICAL FEES AND PRESCRIBING THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH SAID DEPOSITS MAY BE RETURNED.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section Seven Hundred and Two of Ordinance Numbered Sixteen Hundred, known as the Revised Ordinances of the City of Manila, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 702. Contractors for electrical installations; deposits to guaranty the payment of electrical fees, etc. and conditions for the return thereof.- A license to engage in the business or trade of contractor for electrical installation within the city may be issued to any person of legal age who has successfully passed an examination to test his competency, responsibility and skill to engage in or pursue the aforesaid business or trade before a board of electrical examiners appointed by the Mayor: PROVIDED, That no such license shall be issued unless the applicant therefor shall have deposited with the City Treasurer the sum of two hundred pesos in cash to guaranty the payment of all fees for inspections, including penalties, that may become due from said person to the City of Manila as well as to guaranty that all electrical work, fixture work or specialty electrical work to be done under authority of said license shall be in accordance with the provisions of all ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Manila applicable thereto.

The aforesaid deposit shall not be returned to the licensed electrical contractor even after he shall have ceased to be such, unless all works for which said license is by this ordinance required and all works under permits issued to such person shall have been completely inspected and approved and after all fees and other charges due and owing to the City of Manila by said person shall have been paid and all charges, if any pending against said person for any violation of any existing laws, rules and regulations of the City of Manila pertaining to electrical work, fixture work or specialty electrical work shall have been terminated as certified to by the City Electrician."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
