ORDINANCE NO. ....

AN ORDINANCE GIVING THE NAMES OF "DALISAY", "LAKAS", "DAMAYAN", "SALAMISIM" AND "KALINGA" TO THE FIVE (5) PROPOSED STREETS WITHIN THE RIVERSIDE SUBDIVISION AT BARRIO BACOCD, SAMPA-

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila,

SECTION 1. The names of "Dalisay", "Lakas", "Damayan", "Salamisim" and "Kalinga", are hereby given to the five (5) proposed streets within the Riverside Subdivision at Barrio Bacood, Sampaloc, City of Manila, to wit:

- 1. Dalisay This is a private 12-meter street extending from the west end of Calle Baccod to Calle Lubiran in the district of Sampaloc, with a distance of approximately 380 meters;
- This is a private 10-meter street, NW 2. Lakas of and parallel to Calle Bacood, extending from Calle Dalisay to Calle Lubiran in the district of Sampaloc, with a distance of about 350 meters;
- 2. Damayan This is a private 10-meter street, SE. and SW. of am parallel to Calle Dalisay and Lubiran, respectively, extending from Calle Lakas to Calle Lakas in the district of Sampaloc, with a distance of 300 meters more or less;
- 4. Salamisim This is a private 10-meter street, SE. of and parallel to Calle Damayan extending from Calle Bacood to Calle Kalinga, in the district of Sampaloc, with a distance of approximately 170 meters; and
- 5. Kalinga -This is a private 10-meter street, SW. of and parallel to Calle Lubiran, extending from Calle Dalisay to Calle Bacood, in the district of Sampaloc, with a distance of about 190 meters.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
