

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE UNITED CARNIVAL SHOWS FROM THE PAYMENT OF MUNICIPAL LICENSES AND PERMIT FEES REQUIRED FOR THE OPERATION OF ITS EQUIPMENT, IN CONNECTION WITH THE HOLDING OF A FAIR, UNDER THE MANAGEMENT OF SAID ENTITY, IN THE SUNKEN GARDENS NEAR THE JONES BRIDGE, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The United Carnival Shows is hereby exempted from the payment of municipal licenses and permit fees required for the operation of its equipment, in connection with the holding of a fair, under the management of said entity, in the Sunken Gardens near the Jones Bridge, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) That this fair shall be held during the period from November 27, 1948 to December 9, 1948, but which may be reopened from January 2 to January 31, 1949 and that under no circumstances this fair shall be opened during the Boys' Town Carnival from December 10, 1948 to January 1, 1949;
- (2) That the United Carnival Shows shall give to the City of Manila 20% of all the gross receipts of the fair, including gate receipts, auditorium receipts, concessions, advertisements, etc., the same to be expended for the benefit of the Boys' Town;
- (3) That the books of accounts of the fair shall be opened to audit by the city government officials any time, and that the gross receipts will be checked up nightly by said officials upon the closing of the shows; and
- (4) That no gambling of any kind or shows obnoxious to decency and morals shall be permitted within the grounds of the fair.

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
