

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF VETERANS' ASSOCIATION FROM THE PAYMENT OF MUNICIPAL LICENSE FEES AND AMUSEMENT TAX FOR THE REORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE BOYS' TOWN CARNIVAL AND FAIR AT THE WALLACE FIELD FROM MARCH 11 TO APRIL 30, 1949, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The National Federation of Veterans' Association, representing the Philippine Veterans Legion, the Filipino Guerilla Veterans Legion and the Philippine Scouts Veterans Association, is hereby exempted from the payment of the municipal license fees and amusement tax for concessions, rides, shows, circus, arena attractions as well as the construction of booths and other structures, in connection with the reorganization and operation of the Boys' Town Carnival and Fair at the Wallace Field under its auspices from March 11 to April 30, 1949, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) That the National Federation of Veterans' Association shall pay for the use of the properties (structures, improvements, equipment, etc.) of the Boys' Town Carnival and Fair the amount of ₱250.00 a day of actual operation, in the form of lease or rental and that this Association shall be responsible for the custody of the above properties during the period of the operation of this Carnival from March 11 to April 30, 1949: PROVIDED, That the payment of the daily rental of ₱250.00 above mentioned is hereby condoned from March 15 to April 30, 1949.
- (2) That this amount of ₱250.00 shall be paid by said National Federation of Veterans' Association to be delivered to the Office of the City Treasurer before noon of the following working days from March 12 to 15, 1949.
- (3) That the said National Federation of Veterans' Association shall insure the properties of the Boys' Town Carnival and Fair in the name of the City of Manila for an amount not less than ₱10,000.00, the premiums thereof to be paid by the above named National Federation of Veterans' Association;
- (4) That all improvements (materials and structures) which shall be introduced, built or constructed within the Carnival premises by the National Federation of Veterans' Association, (not belonging to the concessioners and advertisers) attached to the grounds shall be turned over, free of charge to the City of Manila for the use of the Boys' Town; and
- (5) That the operation of this Boys' Town Carnival and Fair by the National Federation of Veterans' Association shall be subject to such further terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by both parties.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
