

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 3254, REQUIRING FOOD HANDLERS, BARBERS, MASSEURS, AND BEAUTICIANS TO PAY A LABORATORY AND X-RAY EXAMINATION FEE OF TWO PESOS (P2.00) PER ANNUM, BY INCLUDING THEREIN THE OCCUPATION OF HOSTESSES, AND ALL OTHERS WHO ARE REQUIRED BY EXISTING ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE THEMSELVES WITH HEALTH CERTIFICATES AND, FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3254, requiring food handlers, barbers, masseurs, and beauticians to pay a laboratory and X-Ray examination fee of two pesos (P2.00) and for other purposes, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Food handlers, barbers, masseurs, beauticians, hostesses, and all others who are required by existing ordinances, rules and regulations to submit themselves for periodical laboratory and X-Ray examinations and to secure health certificates at the Office of the City Health Officer, shall pay an annual laboratory and X-Ray examination fee of two pesos (P2.00)."

SEC. 1-a. The fees prescribed in Section 1 hereof shall be collected by the City Treasurer or his representative and shall constitute a revolving fund to be used exclusively for the purchase of necessary equipment, supplies and materials for the Public Health Laboratory and the City Hall Chest Clinic."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as of November 13, 1948.
