

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE PGEA CARNIVAL AND CIRCUS FROM THE PAYMENT OF MUNICIPAL LICENSES ON BUILDING AND ELECTRICAL PERMITS, MAYOR'S PERMIT, ADVERTISEMENTS, FERIAS, EXHIBITS, RIDES, SHOWS, CIRCUSES, DANCING, GAMES AND OTHER FORMS OF ENTERTAINMENTS, AS WELL AS FROM AMUSEMENT TAXES, IN CONNECTION WITH THE HOLDING OF A FAIR AT THE SUNKEN GARDENS FROM DECEMBER 15, 1949 TO JANUARY 15, 1950, UNDER ITS AUSPICES, FOR THE BENEFIT OF A PGEA BUILDING FOR RECREATIONAL AND CULTURAL PURPOSES, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The Philippine Government Employees Association is hereby exempted from the payment of municipal licenses on building and electrical permits, Mayor's permit, advertisements, ferias, exhibits, rides, shows, circuses, dancing, games and other forms of entertainments as well as from amusement taxes, in connection with the holding of a fair at the Sunken Gardens used by the Labor Festival including the vacant spaces available on both sides free of charge from December 15, 1949 to January 15, 1950, under its auspices, for the benefit of a PGEA building for recreational and cultural purposes: PROVIDED, That said Philippine Government Employees Association shall pay the corresponding expenses for the publication of this ordinance in the newspapers.

SEC. 2. All concessioners in the fair referred to in Section One hereof are also hereby exempted from the payment of municipal licenses in the operation of their business therein.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
