

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING DAKOTA STREET "MACARIO ADRIATICO" STREET.

WHEREAS, it was the late Don Macario Adriatico who, as assemblyman from the province of Mindoro, drafted Bill No. 176 which eventually was enacted and became Act No. 1869, a law that amended and practically changed the then Charter of Manila in its entirety by taking away the control and supervision of the government of the City of Manila from the Governor General of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, it is a very lamentable fact that the man who was mainly responsible for the adoption of an autonomous government for the City of Manila is, if at all, scarcely known among the residents of this City; and

WHEREAS, the renaming of a public street in the City of Manila after that illustrious man to whom the people of this metropolis are deeply indebted is a noble way of giving due honor to the late Don Macario Adriatico and of perpetuating his memory in the hearts and minds of the grateful people of this City: Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Dakota Street is hereby renamed "Macario Adriatico" Street.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
