AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OPERATORS OF BARBER SHOPS FROM CONDUCTING THE BUSINESS OF MASSAGING CUSTOMERS OR OTHER PERSONS IN ADJACENT ROOMS OF SAID BARBER SHOPS AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be prohibited for any operator of any barber shop to conduct the business of massaging customers or other persons in any adjacent room or rooms of said barber shop, or in any room or rooms within the same building where the barber shop is located as long as the operator of the barber shop and the rooms where massaging is conducted is the same person.

SEC. 2. "Operator" shall include the owner, manager, administrator or any other person who operates or is responsible for the operation of a barber shop.

SEC. 3. "Massaging" shall mean any system of manipulation or treatment of the superficial parts of the human body by rubbing, stroking or tapping with the hand or an instrument.

SEC. 4. Any operator who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) nor more than Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) or imprisonment of not less than twenty (20) days nor more than six (6) months.

A final conviction for the violation of this Ordinance shall cause the automatic revocation of the permit and license for the operation of the barber shop concerned.


SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


