

AN ORDINANCE RESERVING FOUR HUNDRED (400) SQUARE METERS (20 M. X 20 M.) OF BURIAL SPACE IN THE NORTH CEMETERY, A PORTION OF WHICH IS PRESENTLY UTILIZED AS A RESTING PLACE OF THE ELEVEN BOY SCOUTS WHO WERE KILLED IN AN AIRPLANE CRASH, AS A MEMORIAL SHRINE FOR DECEASED MEMBERS OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES; UNDER CERTAIN CONDITION.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. A lot with an area of four hundred (400) square meters (20 m. x 20 m.), a portion of which is presently utilized as the resting place of the eleven boy scouts who were killed in an airplane crash, is hereby reserved as a memorial shrine for members of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines dying under the same or similar extraordinary circumstances as those attendant to the death of the twenty-three boy scouts who lost their lives in Bombay, India: PROVIDED, That for the occupancy of the same, a nominal fee of P1.00 shall be charged.


SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila at its regular session today, June 25, 1964.




