

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱6,559.52 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE RETIREMENT GRATUITY DUE THE ESTATE OF THE LATE EUGENIO ACOSTA, A FORMER PATROIMAN IN THE MANILA POLICE DEPARTMENT, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1616, AS FURTHER AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 3836.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. The amount of ₱6,559.52, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the payment of the retirement gratuity due the estate of the late Eugenio Acosta, a former patrolman in the Manila Police Department, under the provisions of Republic Act No. 1616, as further amended by Republic Act No. 3836.


SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila at its regular session today, June 30, 1964.


