AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF EMPLOYMENT AGENCIES OR AGENTS IN THE CITY OF MANILA TO PROVIDE SEPARATE AND SANI-TARY QUARTERS FOR MALE AND FEMALE RECRUITS; AND PROVIDING PENAL TY FOR VIOLATION THERBOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Owners or operators of Employment Agencies or agents in the City of Manila are hereby required to provide separate and sanitary quarters for male and female recruits.

For purposes of this Ordinance, "agency" or "employment agent" means any office or person, as the case may be, who, for monetary consideration, habitually, directly or indirectly procures or looks for, or offers or promises to procure or look for, employment or position or a contract for employment or a position, or an employee, laborer or servant, for another person, or a contract for an employee, laborer or servant, with quarters for the purpose while awaiting enployment, except as provided in Act No. 3957.

This definition shall include all associations, firms or companies procuring employment, work or positions for their members or for other persons, except as provided in Act No. 3957.

SEC. 2. The quarters for males and the quarters for females shall each be provided with at least one bathroom and one toilet.

SEC. 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of \$200.00 or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 120 days after its approval.
