

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P165,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE CITY JAIL, INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ISOLATION CELLS AND FENCE, ASPHALT PAVING OF JAIL GROUNDS AND INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC FACILITIES AND ACCESSORIES AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN OFFICE EQUIPMENT, PROJECTOR SPARE PARTS, INSECT FOGGERS, PRISON UNIFORMS, TELEVISION SETS, MOTOR VEHICLES, CARPENTRY MATERIALS AND ELECTRICAL ACCESSORIES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The amount of P165,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the improvement of the City Jail and for the purchase of certain equipment needed therein, itemized as follows:

1. Construction of 40 isolation cells to segregate 80 to 100 troublesome, incorrigible, escape conscious maximum security prisoners:
 - a. Purchase of additional materials .. P12,300.00
 - b. Cost of labor by administration ... 7,000.00 P19,300.00
2. Putting up of "Media Agua" in all prisoner's quarters with bare windows to protect their health from dampness of wet floor due to rains and entry of excessive sunlight:
 - a. Estimated cost of materials P21,660.00
 - b. Cost of labor by 2 carpenters at P6/day for 45 days 540.00 P22,200.00
3. Construction of interlink inner fence along the age-old perimeter walls which are weak and have breaks or openings, for added security 6,500.00
4. Purchase of 100 reflectors and accessories for weather-proof electrical installations of perimeter wall lights 2,500.00
5. Purchase of 25 pairs of hair clippers, (instead of barber's scissors) to cut hair of inmates for sanitation and neatness .. 500.00
6. Purchase of 10 insect foggers, electric, 220-V P 2,000.00
Insecticide or DDT spray to repel mosquitoes, flies, for restful sleep of inmates not provided with mosquito nets 1,000.00 3,000.00
7. Materials for 25 dining tables and benches to replace dilapidated ones in 2 Mess Halls 1,200.00
8. Purchase of prison uniforms (blue and orange) for trustees and sentenced prisoners ... 3,000.00

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9. Purchase of spare parts of movie projector and rent of films. As of now, 16-mm are loaned free by the Manila Theater Association because of which the City Jail cannot be choosy as to the type of movies:

- a. Projector screen and spare parts...P 420.00
- b. Rent of films at P20.00 each 2,080.00 P2,500.00

10. Purchase of 3 standard, heavy-duty typewriters for the Booking Section for records of admitted and released prisoners for the 24-hour period. Only one machine is used by 3 shifts of bookingmen and the same breaks down due to constant use.... 2,700.00

11. Purchase of five (5) TV sets for indoor recreation of inmates 12,500.00

12. Asphalt paving of 9,600 square meters of Jail ground areas to eliminate hiding place of improvised deadly weapons 86,400.00

13. For the vocational rehabilitation of sentenced prisoners, the purchase of two mimeograph machines, manual, at P950.00 each; two paper cutters, 24" at P85.00 each; and book-binding equipment, to turn out mimeographed forms needed by City Jail and other MPD bureaus and to bound prison records and other official documents 2,700.00

T O T A L - - - - - P165,000.00

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
