

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF WRIGHT STREET IN MALATE TO THAT OF "DR. ANTONIO D. VAQUEZ STREET."

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Antonio D. Vaquez distinguished himself in the field of medicine and in the promotion of the welfare of the community;

WHEREAS, he served as Professor of Surgery in the University of the Philippines and as physician in the Philippine General Hospital from 1912 up to his retirement in 1951;

WHEREAS, in 1962, he was awarded a Diploma of Merit as Professor and Head of the Department of Surgery of the University of the Philippines, and in 1965, he was conferred the Title of Professor Emeritus of Surgery of the same institution;

WHEREAS, during his lifetime, he was also active in civic activities and was noted for his kindness and liberality. During the Japanese Occupation, his medical clinic was the refuge of needy patients and his home, the shelter for poor people;

WHEREAS, he was a recognized leader in Industrial Medicine and an advocate of more extensive medical services for factory and office workers, and lived long enough to see many of his ideas incorporated in government regulations affecting the welfare of the working men;

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Antonio D. Vaquez and his family have lived at Wright Street in Malate since 1917;

WHEREAS, as a fitting tribute to the memory of the late Dr. Antonio D. Vaquez, it is only proper that Wright Street be renamed in his honor: Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The name of Wright Street in Malate is hereby changed to that of "Dr. Antonio D. Vaquez Street."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
