AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P200,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PLACING OF RAILINGS ALONG SIDEWALKS OF VARIOUS STREETS IN THE CITY OF MANILA AND AROUND ISLANDS IN MAJOR THOROUGHFARES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. The amount of P200,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the placing of railings along sidewalks located in various streets, central business districts and heavy traffic zones, including schools, churches and other metropolitan areas congested with pedestrians and/or vehicular traffic, in the City of Manila and around islands in major thoroughfares.


SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




