

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱1,000,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE OPERATIONAL EXPENSES OF THE PROPOSED CITY UNIVERSITY OF MANILA, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The amount of ₱1,000,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the operational expenses of the proposed City University of Manila.

SEC. 2. Any disbursement of the amount appropriated in Section 1 hereof shall be through a resolution of the Municipal Board approved by the Mayor: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That purchase of equipment, supplies and materials shall be through public bidding and shall be held only upon prior and proper certification by the City Treasurer as to the availability of funds; that expenses for wages and salaries shall be accompanied by plantilla of personnel; that all other disbursements shall be in accordance with all pertinent legal and auditing requirements; and that the President of the University shall submit a quarterly report of the expenditures of the University to the Offices of the Municipal Board and of the Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer of said Body.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board of Manila on November 24, 1967, and modified today, December 21, 1967.
