

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱2,500.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A POLICE OUTPOST, INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL AND TELEPHONE FACILITIES THEREIN, ALONG THE RAILROAD TRACKS BETWEEN LAGUNA AND KAGANDAHAN EXTENSIONS, GAGALANGIN, TONDO, FOR THE USE OF THE POLICE COMMUNITY RELATION DISTRICT COMMITTEE, DISTRICT NO. 34.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. The amount of ₱2,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the construction of a police outpost, including the installation of electrical and telephone facilities therein, along the railroad tracks between Laguna and Kagandahan extensions, Gagalangin, Tondo, as indicated in the sketch submitted for the purpose, for the use of the Police Community Relation District Committee, District No. 34.


SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


