WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the use of said new official seal and to penalize the unauthorized use thereof:
Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The City of Manila hereby adopts as its official seal the symbol described in the preceding preamble and reproduced thereunder.

SEC. 2. Any utterance in speech, writing or drawing, and/or any act or emission easting dishenor, ridicule or contempt upon the above-described new official seal of the City of Manila, as well as its use as trademarks and/or for industrial, commercial or agricultural labels or designs, and any drawings or inscriptions upon the new official seal, are hereby prohibited, and their execution shall constitute a misdemeanor.

SEC. 3. Any person who, either by himself or through another, violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine or not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Gourt.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Asst. Secretary & Adm. Officer Municipal Board, Manila AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL SEAL FOR THE CITY OF MANILA, REGULATING THE USE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR UNAUTHOR-IZED USE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, His Honor, Mayor Antonio J. Villegas, with the favorable endorsement of the Philippine Heraldry Committee and the approval of His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, has proclaimed a new efficial seal for the City of Manila, the heraldric description and reproduction of which are as follows:

On a field of gules (red), the palisades of Rajah Soliman proper in argent (silver), superimposed on which are the following symbols on each point of an imaginary triangle: Top is the Malayan script K gules; on the base are the San Agustin and the gates of Fort Santiago proper in or (gold);

Surrounding the blazon is a nilad garland, verte (green);

On the crest is the distinctive sumburst or "Araw ng Maynila" in or (gold);

Surrounding the circular escutcheon is a band agure (blue) on which the text \*TIMBULAN NG LAYA AT DIWANG DAKHA\* in or (gold) top; and

\*LUNGSOD NG MAYNILA\* in or (gold), base, and finally, the years 1571 and 1963 in gules (red), are properly inscribed.
