AN ORDINANCE RENAMING TANDUAY STREET IN THE DISTRICT OF SAN MIGUEL "JOSE NEPOSUCENO STREET."

WHEREAS, the late Jose Neposuceno, founder of the first Filipino movie industry, spent the best years of life in the development of the movie industry in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the late Jose Neposuceno's fervent quest for better, enjoyable and educational entertainment in the movie industry, coupled with his indefatigable efforts, seemingly inexhaustible energies and undying devotion to local film making, has undoubtedly made possible the movie industry in this country to flourish into what it is today;

WHEREAS, as the coming year will mark the fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the first Filipino movie industry in the Philippines and it is, therefore, fitting and appropriate to honor the man who pioneered in Philippine movie industry, the man who has been known as the "Father of the Filipino Movie" by naming certain street in the city to perpetuate his memory: Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Tanduy Street in the District of San Miguel is hereby renamed "Jose Neposuceno Street."

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila at its regular session on December 21, 1967 and reiterated today, January 18, 1968.
