AN ORDINANCE RENAMING BAHALA NA STREET IN TONDO "REMIGIO H. MABAGOS STREET".

WHEREAS, Technical Sergeant Remigio H. Mabagos, a Philcag trooper who was killed in action in Tay Ninh, South Vietnam, was a well-decorated soldier, the most notable of his awards being the Gold Cross Medal for gallantry in action for singlehandedly engaging the enemy group which resulted in the capture of Huk Commander Benjamin Cunanan and his aide, and the Military Merit Medal for being a member of the Special Intelligence Operation that saw the capture of Dr. Jesus Lava, Secretary-General and Supremo of the Huk organization;

WHEREAS, he was born in Tondo on March 26, 1928, and had his permanent residence at Bahala Na Street, Tondo, until his death;

WHEREAS, his heroic achievements deserve the commendation and recognition of the people of Manila; and

WHEREAS, the name "Bahala Na" has been consistently associated with a notorious group of lawless elements in Tondo;

WHEREAS, naming Bahala Na Street after Remigio H. Mabagos will not only be in keeping with the peace-loving and God-fearing atmosphere in that neighborhood but will also be a fitting acknowledgement of his patriotic exploits; Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SEC. 1. Bahala Na Street is hereby renamed "Remigio H. Mabagos Street".

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
