

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P20,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO COVER THE EXPENSES TO BE INCURRED BY JUDGE CESAR SANGCO OF THE CITY COURT OF MANILA, IN CONNECTION WITH HIS TRIP TO SOME COUNTRIES ABROAD, FOR THE PURPOSE OF STUDYING AND OBSERVING JUDICIAL PROCEDURES THEREAT, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The amount of P20,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available to cover the expenses to be incurred by Judge Cesar Sangco of the City Court of Manila, in connection with his trip to some countries abroad, for the purpose of studying and observing judicial procedures thereat, subject to the following conditions:

1. That this projected trip of Judge Cesar Sangco shall have the prior approval of the Office of the President of the Philippines; that booking shall be made with the National Flag Carrier and/or its connecting facilities; and that transportation expenses incurred not in consonance herewith shall not be allowed in audit unless with a certification from the National Flag Carrier of the non-availability of its facilities for the trip; and
2. That said Judge Cesar Sangco shall submit within fifteen (15) days after his return from abroad a typewritten report of his trip, furnishing the Office of the President, the Office of the Municipal Board and the Office of the Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer of said Body with copies of his report.


SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila on May 30, 1968, vetoed by His Honor, the Mayor on June 14, 1968 and the veto overridden today, June 20, 1968.
