

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DIGGINGS AND EXCAVATIONS IN THE STREETS AND THOROUGHFARES OF THE CITY OF MANILA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. All diggings and excavations in the streets and thoroughfares of the City of Manila for the installation or repair of gas pipes, water pipes, telephone or telegraph cables, electric wires or cables, sewage pipes and drainage facilities done by private parties or by government personnel shall be undertaken continuously twenty-four hours a day on a three-workshift basis until the work shall have been completed.

SEC. 2. The diggings and excavations mentioned in Section 1 hereof shall be provided with appropriate markers and, at nighttime, with sufficient blinking red lights.

SEC. 3. The City Engineer shall, in the issuance of any permit for the undertaking of any work covered in Section 1 hereof, impose the requirements contained the next preceding two sections as conditions of the permit.


SEC. 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than ₱150.00 or by imprisonment for not less than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court. In the case of corporations, partnerships or associations, the president, manager or the person in charge of the project shall be liable.


SEC. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
